

Add a YouTube Video in Canvas Pages

In Canvas, you can add YouTube Videos as visual learning resources. Two options are available to allow a video to be placed within a page for quick viewing.

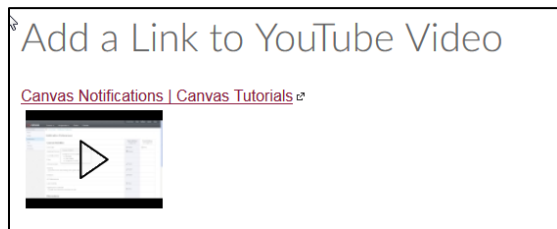
YouTube Options

These are the two options for adding a YouTube video to your Canvas page.

- A. **Embed a video** – This option provides a larger video frame and is useful for focusing on one video within a page

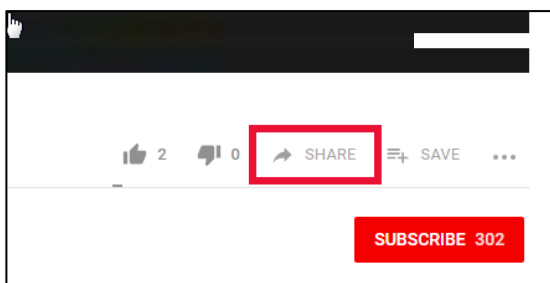


- B. **Add a link to a video** – This option provides a video button and works best when adding multiple videos to one page

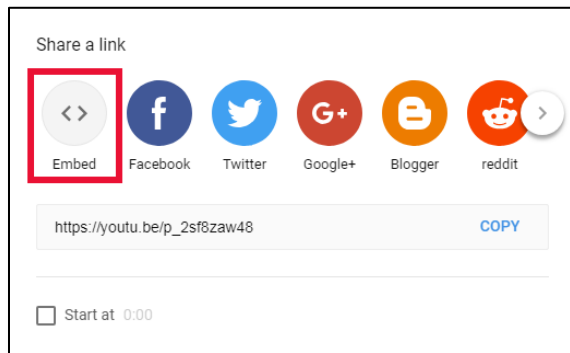


Embed the Video

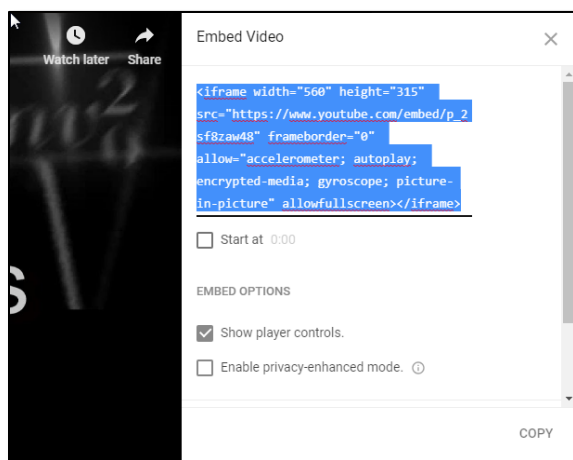
1. In YouTube, Click the **Share** option, located beneath the video



2. In the share window, click the **Embed** option.



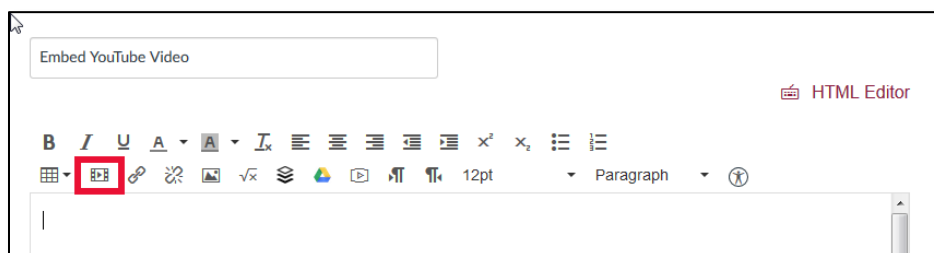
3. **Highlight** the code in the box, key **Ctrl + C** (Mac: **Cmd +C**) on the keyboard to copy the code



4. In Canvas, click **Edit** on the page where you need to add the video



5. Click the **“Insert/edit media”** icon button in the text options



6. In the Insert/edit media window:
 - a. Click the **Embed** tab
 - b. **Paste using Ctrl + V (Mac: Cmd + V), the code you copied from YouTube**
 - c. Click **Ok**

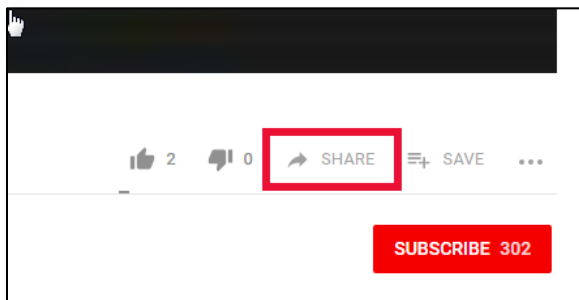


7. Click **Save and Publish** or **Save**

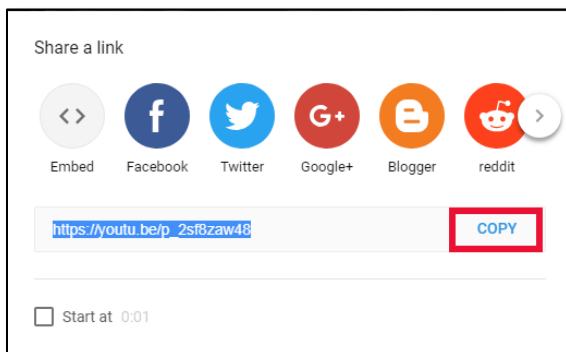


Add a Link to YouTube Video

1. In YouTube, Click the **Share** option, located beneath the video



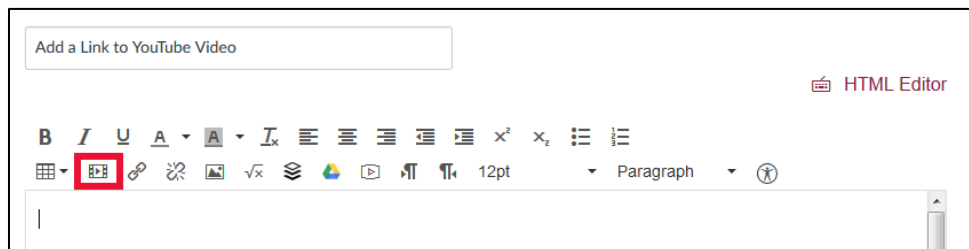
2. In the Share window, **highlight** the Link and click **Copy**



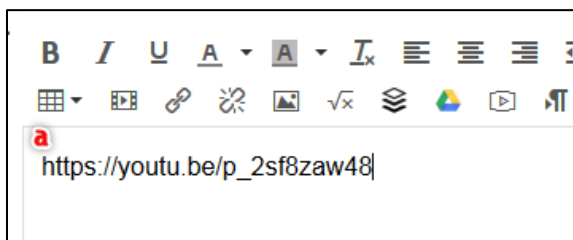
3. In Canvas, click **Edit** on the page where you need to add the video



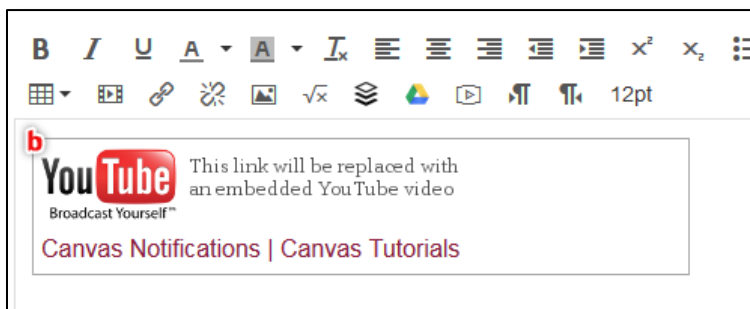
4. Click the “Insert/edit media” icon button in the text options



5. Add the YouTube link to the text box
a. Paste using **Ctrl + V** (Mac: **Cmd + V**), the copied code in the text box



- b. Key **Enter** on the keyboard to connect the link to YouTube. The link will then change to a YouTube box



6. Click **Save and Publish** or **Save**
